1. Opening Prayer

Fr. Mosimann opened the meeting with a prayer and introduced Cliff Lapetoda, the Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus, and Gloria Cañas, who was representing the Spanish-speaking members of the parish at Fr. Mosimann's invitation.

2. SJA History Project

Mr. Merle Garvis gave the Council an update on the Seniors Group project to publish a history of our parish, for which they are seeking funds. Ms. Davis summarized the Council's position that the cost can't be justified while we are building the new church, and the council would prefer to include the completed church, so either a simpler version could be published now, or we could wait until the new church is finished to publish a more elaborate book.

3. New Church

Mr. Tschida reported that the database has 2239 pledge cards and that we have made at least 652 visits. The blended approach of visits and letters is working. Mr. Knauer reported that we have a low number of pledges, but with high dollar amounts. We will conduct an in-pew campaign in October.

Mr. Knauer reported that the special exception is moving very quickly through the town planning process. Our master schedule still has us breaking ground in June 2010, but the dedication will likely be pushed back to early 2012.

4. Committee Reports

Mr. Lapetoda reported on the Knights of Columbus recent activities. He noted that this year the Knights are focusing on charitable service projects and becoming more involved with the youth of the parish.

Mr. Ange reported that our assets are at \$5 million. Offertory is down somewhat, but neither are we spending as much.

Ms. Wagner reported that she is seeing more requests for help and that we have completed critical outreach for one family by collecting food, gas, and gift cards. Our back-to-school drive was a big success and now we are trying to get items for families involved in the prison ministry.

Ms. Trask announced that Sign-Up Sunday will be on November 7 and 8.

5. Old Business

Fr. Mosimann reported that things are unchanged and we are still awaiting a bilingual priest. The youth Mass will be discontinued after the next meeting because of the extensive preparations it requires. Fr.

Mosimann has had requests for two Latin Masses per month and we may begin that in January. Ms. Davis reported that the Parish Council web page went live this summer.

6. New Business

Fr. Mosimann asked the group's opinion on suspending Holy Communion under both species because of the flu. Most members believe measures are not needed at this time. Fr. Mosimann concluded that he will put a notice in the bulletin explaining the possibility of only one species and why, and then simply make weekly decisions as necessary.

7. Next Meetings and Adjournment

The next meetings will be on November 4, January 6, March 3, and May 5. After Fr. Mosimann led a closing prayer, the meeting adjourned at 9:50 PM.
