1. Opening Prayer and Review of Minutes

Fr. Mosimann opened the meeting with a prayer at 7:30 PM. The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

2. New Church Report

Fr. Mosimann announced that we have chosen Whiting-Turner as our contractors. After some discussion, council members agreed the groundbreaking ceremony should be on October 2. The contractors have submitted a 16-month construction schedule, and intend to have the concrete poured by the end of the year. Mr. Tschida and Mr. Knauer reviewed the communication plan. Our next capital campaign focus will be on the 1700 families who have not pledged, and will begin with the 800 of those who have given so far through other channels. They will receive one phone call attempt to set up a visit.

3. Committee Reports

Mr. Patania reviewed the projects that Knights completed this summer and asked for suggestions for future projects. The Knights are planning their membership blitz, Advent and Lenten retreats for the men of the parish, their Memorial Mass, and Christmas activities. They are also looking for a coordinator for the "Keep Christ in Christmas" card sale.

Mr. Ange summarized the state of our accounts and noted that though collections are down a little, the offertory is level. Expenses are better than planned.

Ms. Wagner reported that the Walk for Life had a good turnout and may become an annual event. She is investigating future drives for collections for Haiti or Pakistan and the upcoming Holiday Coalition. Ms. Trask reported that Sign-Up Sunday will be moved to October 16 and 17 to accommodate the groundbreaking

4. Old and New Business

Fr. Mosimann reported that the Corpus Christi event was successful. Ms. Davis asked the Council to bring to the next meeting ideas for another basket for this year's auction.

Ms. Davis explained that we are going to investigate having the second collection immediately after first. We will try it at the 7:00 am Mass.
