1. Opening Prayer and Review of Minutes

Fr. Mosimann opened the meeting with a prayer at 7:30 PM. The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

2. New Church Report

Fr. Mosimann reported that our Liturgy Subcommittee is working on interior design and that we have purchased some major furnishings from a closed church in New Jersey. Construction permits have gone through, and we have the grading done and are working on the pad. Fr. Mosimann also received permission from the bishop to move Confirmation from the fall to the spring so we can hold it in the new church. The wine sale netted \$7200 so far and the in-pew campaign resulted in 150 new pledges for an additional \$500 thousand.

3. Committee Reports

The Knights will be advertising the diocesan Men's Conference at St. Joseph's on March 19. Other upcoming events for the Knights are the March for Life, Heritage Hall choir and cookies event for Valentine's Day, and supporting the auction.

Mr. Ange summarized the state of our accounts and noted that we are currently ahead of budget.

Ms. Wagner said that Outreach could have handled more early requests for holiday assistance. More volunteers are needed for the Transportation Assistance program. Outreach is currently investigating ways to get the youth of the parish more involved with service projects.

Ms. Trask is scheduling next year's Sign-Up Sunday.

4. Old and New Business

Ms. Davis noted that the Council will sponsor a wine gift basket idea.

Mr. Ange reported that the communion rail needs to be repaired and refinished before it is installed in the Little Church.

Fr. Mosimann announced that the diocese will again be doing the Keep the Light On program on Wednesdays during Lent.

6. Next Meetings and Adjournment

The next meeting was scheduled for March 5. After Fr. Mosimann led a closing prayer, the meeting adjourned at 9:15 PM.
