1. Opening Prayer and Review of Minutes

Fr. Mosimann opened the meeting with a prayer at 7:30 PM. The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

2. New Church Report

Mr. Wynn reported that the building site news is all good. The first slab is in place and steel beams are being erected. We are taking weekly photos of the building's progress. We are working on interior design plans now and will be purchasing new pews rather than reuse the older ones to prevent the congregation from being distracted from the liturgy by discomfort. We are formulating a memorials program to fund furnishings that we hope to launce before Easter. We have collected more than \$3 million so far in pledges for the Capital Campaign, including \$205 thousand this year.

3. Committee Reports

The Knights are looking for someone to assist with the administration of the car raffle.

Mr. Ange summarized the state of our accounts and noted that we are currently ahead of budget and that we have applied for a preservation grant for \$3850 to restore the altar rail in the Little Church.

Ms. Wagner noted that this year, the youth will assist with the Easter Basket drive. Next she explained that we still need more Transportation Assistance volunteers.

Ms. Trask reported that the Stewardship Committee met to discuss where we want to be as a parish with stewardship. They would like to conduct a talent survey to collect information and manage a database and are working on a more extensive directory.

4. Old and New Business

Ms. Davis thanked the Council for their wine gift basket for the auction.

Fr. Mosimann announced that additional parking, about 20 spaces, has been added along the road into the cemetery. He further said that we may make the road one way during Masses to improve traffic flow.

Fr. Mosimann said that we will be having Stations of the Cross in Spanish at 8:30.

6. Next Meetings and Adjournment

The next meeting was scheduled for May 4. After Fr. Mosimann led a closing prayer, the meeting adjourned at 9:20 PM.
