1. Opening Prayer and Review of Minutes

Fr. Mosimann opened the meeting with a prayer at 7:30 PM. He introduced new members, Mariano Buitrago and Dan Fagerli, and thanked former members, Gloria Cañas, Bill Knauer, Tom Van Nuys, and Margaret Santos. The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

2. New Church Report

Mr. Knauer reported, "Mission accomplished." We have testing alternative configurations of the sound system with the sound consultant. One possible solution will be to move speakers down (they are currently in the lights) and to add acoustic dampening to the high walls in the transept.

The St. John statue we ordered is on its way from Italy and is due to be installed in late October, as are railings for the shrines. Mr. Wynn noted that construction is basically complete. We had 277 punch list items and 247 of them are done. Ms. Hertz explained that we began giving tours every Saturday after dedication and at the picnic on October 7. We are advertising them in the local newspaper and could use more volunteers.

3. Committee Reports

The Knights will again be meeting in the Parish Center, beginning in September, in the auditorium (old worship space). Six local councils are working together to raise money to buy an ultrasound machine.

Mr. Ange noted that at the end of the fiscal year, our income was currently ahead of budget by 4.3% and our expenses were 7.4% better than planned.

Ms. Restivo said we collected more than twice the school supplies for the Back To School Drive than we had in previous years. We have also supported the Run for the Unborn on September 3.

Ms. Trask reported that Sign-Up Sunday will be on September 22 and 23 and encourages all ministries to have representation at their tables through all Masses.

Ms. Davis explained we would like to have more fellowship events, such as ice cream socials and regular doughnut Sundays. We need a hospitality chair as well as coordinators for each type of event.

4. Old and New Business

Ms. Sheehan reported that coding has begun on the new website. We have four people who will roll over the content and we hope it will be complete in a few weeks.

Fr. Mosimann will be conducting a survey to determine new Mass times for a reduced schedule. He also mentioned that people are parking too close to the corner, and police will be monitoring the situation.

6. Next Meetings and Adjournment

The next meeting was scheduled for November 7. After Fr. Mosimann led a closing prayer, the meeting adjourned at 9:45 PM.
