1. Opening Prayer and Review of Minutes

Fr. Mosimann opened the meeting with a prayer at 7:30 PM. The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

2. New Church Report

All items on the punch list have been completed. We will be remodeling the steps leading to King Street to VDOT standards. The sound problems seem to be resolved, and lectors have undergone training and were advised to speak loudly and slowly.

3. Committee Reports

Mr. Hudes reported that the six parishes in the area raised almost enough money to purchase two ultrasound machines, not just one. They are looking for a recipient for the second machine and thank the parish for their generous support.

The Finance Committee reported that our collection was 16.5% better than plan and expenses were 2.6% better than plan. We have now capitalized all the work on the new church from day one.

The dates September 21 and 22 were selected for Sign-Up Sunday. The committee has a small group working on a strategic plan for stewardship at our parish. Colleen Wist is the new Hospitality Ministry Chair and Samantha Powers has taken the lead on the Lenten Suppers.

4. Old and New Business

Ms. Trask suggested some changes to improve flow of traffic and safety, and the group agreed there must be a plan and a bulletin notice about the traffic and pedestrian issue, especially for Palm Sunday and Easter.

Fr. Mosimann held meetings with Eucharistic ministers to explain expectations: to serve when assigned, be prepared to serve when not assigned, live in accordance with the church, and offer 30 minutes of adoration a week.

Fr. Mosimann advised that there were 60 applicants for the music director position. A committee selected the top eight candidates and he will be conducting a second round of interviews with the top two candidates.

Fr. Mosimann mentioned that he is looking for an Ecumenical representative to serve as a diocesan liaison.

6. Next Meetings and Adjournment

The next meeting was scheduled for May 1. After Fr. Mosimann led a closing prayer, the meeting adjourned at 9:00 PM.
