1. Opening Prayer and Review of Minutes

Fr. Mosimann opened the meeting with a prayer at 7:30 PM. The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

2. New Church Report

Fr. Mosimann explained that a problem with the sound was the result of too much solder, and that has been repaired. Two stained glass windows were installed in the tower.

For the capital campaign, Mr. Tschida reported that we have collected \$525 thousand in pledges since November, and \$5.29 million overall. Giving has been steady so far this year. We have installed the second round of memorial bricks in the garden.

3. Committee Reports

Mr. Hudes distributed a list of activities before the meeting and highlighted the upcoming visit by the bishop. The bishop will dedicate an ultrasound machine, and all the pastors from the churches who donated the funds are invited.

Ms. Restivo said the ministries have been running individually for the last few months and she'll have more to report at the next meeting.

Ms. Trask stated that the stewardship group is working on the vision statement, focus areas, and communication plan to package and present to Fr. Mosimann. She reported that the Helping Hands ministry is going well, but is able to support more requests for help.

4. Old and New Business

Ms. Sheehan reported that the website visitors number continues to grow. Mr. Buitrago noted that items on our Facebook page reach two thousand people and usage also continues to grow.

Fr. Mosimann noted that the new traffic pattern seems to be working and thanked the Knights and council members for their help.

Ms. Davis explained that we are exploring the possibility of offering the fellowship hall space for funeral receptions. The fellowship ministry will investigate and prepare a proposal.

Fr. Mosimann appointed Ms. Hertz to organize a small reception after the 5:30 mass on August 3 to celebrate the first anniversary of the dedication of the new church.

Fr. Mosimann mentioned that he knew of another priest who may be able to serve the Extraordinary Form of the Latin mass another Sunday each month, and fifth Sundays.

5. Adjournment

After Fr. Mosimann led a closing prayer, the meeting adjourned at 9:30 PM.
