# What is your child being taught?

## What's in the Family Life Education (FLE) lesson plan?

- Primary students are prematurely introduced to the reproductive system.
- Middle and high school content normalizes children to consent to sex and introduces sexual behavior that may undermine or encourage questioning their parent's beliefs or their cultural and religious values.
- FLE curriculum is not available online for parents to review.
- The 2018-19 lesson plans include topics on human trafficking and dating violence for students who may not be ready to hear it.
