



The US Catholic Bishops have designated a fortnight for freedom from the Feast of St Thomas More through Independence Day to raise consciousness about the threat to freedom of religion in our country. In support of this effort, we have several activities planned at St Johns.

- This weekend a novena to St Thomas More will be distributed at mass. Please consider praying this novena at home with your family or joining us at 7pm each evening in the little church – from Monday June 25 through Tuesday, July 3.
- Please consider participating in extended 24/7 adoration hours in our King St chapel during the Fortnight – from Thursday, June 21 9am through Sunday June 24 at 10pm (with breaks Saturday and Sunday afternoon for prescheduled events) and Thursday June 28 at 9am through Sunday July 1 at 10pm (with one break Saturday afternoon).
- Please consider days of fasting and abstinence during the Fortnight similar to those observed during Lent: abstaining from meat on Wednesdays and Fridays and limiting food intake to two meals for the two Fridays.
- Pray for our country, our leaders and our church.
